## SALTONSTALL PINOT NOIR 2017

### Petaluma Gap

#### WINEMAKER NOTES

Saltonstall is the furthest vineyard site from the winery that we source from for our Single Vineyard program, which is why we have to be extra cautious on the picking schedule and logistics to make sure the fruit is delivered to the winery in the same condition as harvested. The grapes are picked in small yellow bins and transported to the winery in a refrigerated truck. The vineyard's exposure to the wind causes thicker skins on the grapes which produces a wine with a deeper and darker color. We receive three clones from this site: 667, 777 and 115. We are able to ferment the lots separately as well as play with temperatures during fermentation to bring out more complexities from the site.

#### ABOUT THE VINEYARD

Saltonstall Vineyard is located in the Petaluma Gap AVA, 30 miles north of San Francisco and 14 miles from the Pacific Ocean. The 19 acre hillside parcel rests in a bucolic landscape surrounded by dairy farms and sheep pastures. The vineyard is planted on the valley floor and receives a great amount of fog and wind. Soils are loamy clay with a touch of gravel settled on the clay.

<b>Color</b>	Dark ruby with a pink rim
<b>On the Nose</b>	Graphite, hops, new leather, licorice, black tea, crème de cassis and black cherry
<b>On the Palate</b>	A concentrated and dense structure with notes of strawberry rhubarb pie, dragon fruit, black cherry, minerality, leather and tobacco on the finish
<b>Varietal</b>	Pinot Noir
<b>Fermentation</b>	Stainless steel open top fermentation tanks
<b>Aging</b>	9 months, in French oak barrels with 25% of them being new
<b>Vineyards</b>	Saltonstall Vineyard
<b>Alcohol by Vol.</b>	13.0%
